



BRSC Inclement Weather Notification Systems

We have a new Weather Station and Lightning Detection System at Burbank, and weather monitoring systems at our Independence Park, Central Sports Park, and Flanacher Road Park locations.

Burbank System

The lightning system at Burbank Soccer Complex is set to alert when there is lightning within a 10 mile radius of the park. This alert is one loud blast from our two horn system and can be seen after the initial horn has gone off by the flashing lights atop the pavilion by field 6 for the front of the complex, and the bathroom by field 17 for the back of the complex. When you hear the horns from the lightning alert system have your players, coaches, and fans pick up all of their belongings and find shelter. The safest place to be during a lightning delay at Burbank is in your vehicle with all doors closed and windows rolled up, or under one of our 3 lightning safe pavilions located by fields 4, 6, and 20. When the lightning has moved out of the 10 mile radius for the duration of 15 minutes the horns will sound the all-clear which is a series of 3 short horn bursts, and the flashing lights will turn off. At this point it is safe to re-enter the fields.

Independence, Flanacher, and Central Systems

If lightning is within a 10 mile radius of any of these three parks we will send out a mass text message to the appropriate locations alerting that there is a lightning delay for that location and to quickly clear the fields. When you receive the lightning alert text message have your players, coaches, and fans pick up all of their belongings and find shelter. The safest place to be during a lightning alert at these locations is in your vehicle with all doors closed and windows rolled up. When the lightning has moved out of the 10 mile radius for the duration of 15 minutes you will receive an All-Clear text message. At this point it is safe to re-enter the fields.

For iOS Users:

1. Go App Store search "WeatherBug" and download app
2. Open app and at the top of the screen touch the location name
3. Select the "Add" location button
4. Type 70810 for the zip code
5. Select "Highland Estates"
6. Select "Baton Rouge Soccer Club"

For Android Users:

1. Make sure phone's locations settings is on
2. Go to Google Play, select "Apps" and search "Weather Bug" and install the app
3. Open app and at the top of the screen touch the location name
4. Select the "Add" location button
5. Type 70810 for the zip code
6. Select "Highland Estates"
7. Select "Baton Rouge Soccer Club"
