Role of first Responders

- Immediate care for the injured or ill athlete.
- Emergency equipment retrieval.
- Activate emergency medical system (EMS) and give:
 - Name, title, address, phone number
 - Nature of the emergency/injury, sex, approximate age of injured
 - Condition of the injured and care being administered to the injured.
 - Specific directions to the location of the injured (refer to venue map)
 - Other information as requested.
 - DO NOT HANG UP UNTIL INSTRUCTED TO DO SO BY EMERGENCY DISPATCH
- Direct EMS to the scene
 - Designate individual to meet EMS and direct them to the scene using the most appropriate entrance for the location of the emergency.
- If EMS is approaching from Bluebonnet Blvd., the first entrance on the right will be at field two.
 The second entrance on the right will be at field 6.
- o If EMS is approaching from Siegan lane, the first entrance on the left will be at field 6. The second entrance on the left will be at field 2.
